Budget Hearing Meeting 6:30 P.M.

Supervisor Aubertine called the Hearing for the 2022 Final Budget to order at 6:30 pm.

Supervisor Aubertine recorded the minutes due to a sickness in the Town Clerks family.

Supervisor Aubertine did not read the Proof of Publication as it was not available.

Supervisor Aubertine read the Proposal Explanation.

Since there was no public in attendance, Supervisor Aubertine did not hold a public information time.

There were no town board comments or concerns regarding the proposed Final Budget.

Resolution 2021-160: Councilman Dan Villa made a motion at 6:35 pm to adjourn the Budget Hearing, seconded by Councilor Julia Gosier. All in favor.

Resolution 2021-161: Motion to go into open meeting made at 6:36 pm by Councilor Julia Gosier, seconded by Councilor Terry Countryman. All in favor.

Resolution 2021-162: Motion to adopt the 2022 Final Budget made by Councilor Dan Villa, seconded by Councilor Julia Gosier. In favor, Supervisor Aubertine, Councilor Bourquin, Councilor Gosier and Councilor Countryman. Opposed Councilor Villa.

Councilman Villa brought up the fact that many permitted seasonal mobile homes along County Route 57 are still in place. According to our zoning laws, all seasonal mobile homes must be removed by November 30th each year. Permits are issued from April to November.

Councilor Countryman updated the board on the Joint Ambulance progress. Councilor Countryman met with the officers of the Chaumont Volunteer Fire Department, per their request, regarding clarification on the district boundary and First Responder Certificates of Need. Cape Vincent Ambulance Representative Jeff Call will look into this request and get back to Councilor Countryman.
