Should you require an absentee ballot or information regarding the same, please contact the Town Clerk's Office at the above referenced address, or by fax at (315)649-2049 or email at lymetownclerk@twcny.rr.com. A form will need to be completed. The request for the absentee ballot may be made at any time, but if the request is being made by mail, it must be received at least seven (7) days prior to July 17, 2018. In the event the request is being made in person, it can be made even the day before. The absentee ballot must be post marked no later than July 17, 2018 and received by the Town within five (5) business days thereafter. The absentee ballots will be counted at that time. It is not sufficient to fax or email a copy of the absentee ballot back. The original ballot must be received.
