Supervisor Aubertine called tonight's meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

All Town Board Members were present at tonight's meeting; there were others in attendance.

## **CREG Systems – Fire Alarm and Key Pad Repairs**

There have been problems with the hard wired fire alarm system and also the key pads for the Municipal Office security system. The fire alarm is no longer in working order, NYS Code states that the system has to be in working order at all times to be in compliance with the Law. There also has to be pull alarms at each entrance, which we do not have.

There are also problems with the security key pad; alarm codes cannot be successfully set prior to entering and exiting the building, causing security concerns with the alarm system.

The Town Board decided to contact CREG Systems and STAT Communications for estimates for updates to the existing systems or replacement costs.
